



Head Coach Position - 2023

The Calverton Chargers are hiring a head coach starting for the 2023 season. Calverton has approximately 130-150 swimmers of all abilities, starting with our mini bolts program. Our new head coach should create opportunities for all swimmers to have fun, build confidence, learn teamwork and good sportsmanship through competitive swimming. The Chargers will compete in Division I in 2023.

Qualifications:

- Previous experience as head coach, or at least 2-3 seasons as assistant coach
- Current lifeguarding and CPR certifications required
- Strong leadership and interpersonal skills
- Current Montgomery County pool operator's license required (or willingness to obtain license)
- Experience with TeamUnify or another swim management program is a plus

Responsibilities & Expectations:

- Coach all swim meets throughout the season from Time Trials through All-Stars
- Create weekly line-ups for all meets: A meets, B meets, Relay Carnivals, Divisionals
- Lead and manage team at all meets, including Coaches Long Course and All-Stars
- Knowledge of MCSL policies, rules, and procedures
- Communicate effectively with team representatives, parents, and swimmers of all abilities
- Ability to recruit, manage, guide, train, and supervise assistant coaches during all practices and meets
- Coach daily morning and evening practices from Memorial Day through All-Star Weekend
- Ability to coach swimmers, regardless of ability level, in all 4 competitive strokes
- Ability to break down stroke mechanics and teach basic skills
- Develop plans for swim practices that balance stroke work, endurance training, and fun
- Provide constructive feedback and instruction to all swimmers
