- Attend all team practices, time trials, A/B meets, mini-meets, and championship meets.
- Attend scheduled non-meet events such as pre-season registration meetings, spirit events, Saturday post-meet luncheons and Thursday night ice cream social/awards ceremonies
- Current life guard/CPR certification required before season begins
