



2023 Mohican Swim Team Assistant Head Coach Position

The Mohican Swim Team seeks an experienced Assistant Head Coach for the 2023 summer season. The Mohican Swim Team is a vibrant part of the community pool, located in the Glen Echo area of Bethesda. The team is composed of young beginners, returning summer swimmers and year-round club swimmers. Mohican maintains a very large team of approximately 250 swimmers, with over 70 pre-team members and will compete in MCSL Division C during summer 2023.

Assistant Head Coach Role and Responsibilities:

The Assistant Head Coach reports directly to the Head Coach. The Assistant Head Coach will:

- Work collaboratively during the pre-season with Team Reps and Head Coach to plan team information events and to schedule new team member and 8U in-water evaluations;
- Coach morning and afternoon practices (afternoon practices begin mid-May, morning practices begin mid-June after MCPS school ends);
- Work directly with the Head Coach to administer team line-ups for all Wednesday, Saturday, and Championship Meets through July 2023;
- Work with the Head Coach to train and manage a group of paid and volunteer junior coaches;
- Motivate, provide clear technical instruction and feedback to all swimmers regardless of age or ability;
- Communicate effectively with all swimmers, team parents, coaches, and pool personnel in a timely and professional manner;
- Demonstrate and promote good sportsmanship and team spirit in conjunction with MCSL and pool rules; and
- Participate in team social events, including weekly Friday evening team dinners & pep rallies, occasional team outings and the team banquet.

Position Qualifications:

- Experience as an assistant coach for an MCSL team preferred;
- Possess outstanding organizational, interpersonal communication skills, preferably with a larger and/or growing team or in another instructional setting;
- Understand the use and application of MCSL policies, rules, procedures;
- Hy-Tek Meet Manager and/or Swim Topia knowledge preferred; and
- Current CPR certification and/or lifeguarding certification preferred.
