We have approximately 100 swimmers each summer with a range of swimming experience and ability and prioritize good sportsmanship, fun, and team spirit. We are seeking to hire a Head Coach who is highly motivated and can meet the following job requirements:

- Strong understanding of MCSL summer swimming rules and procedures;
- Lifeguard and CPR certification current as of job start date;
- Work in cooperation with the Assistant Head Coach to conduct and supervise morning and afternoon practices, ensuring that swimmers are under constant supervision, providing individual and group instruction and feedback, and maintaining an active and energetic coaching style during practices;
- Planning and coaching at all A and B Meets, A and B Relays, MCSL Coaches Long Course, All-Star Relays and All-Stars Individuals meets, and the MCSL Divisional Meet;
- Running a pre-meet warm-up practice; developing a swimmer line-up; serving as liaison with opposing team head coach; leading cheers; and giving swimmers encouragement and reminders prior to swims and positive feedback and “work on this” reminders after swims.
- Coordinate and meet regularly with the Swim Team A and B Reps to jointly provide values-driven leadership for the Swim Team;
- Incorporate character-building values into coaching, including, individual responsibility, sportsmanship, self-confidence, compassion, and competitive spirit;
- Provide necessary information to parents, address parent question/concerns
- Participate in all team functions, and
- Coordinating, managing, and supervising the entire coaching staff to effectively and efficiently accomplish the above responsibilities.
