- Attend all scheduled A&B meets (including time trials, long course, all-stars, PIRC, etc.)
- Communicate effectively and appropriately with swimmers and parents
- Be a team player with coaching staff to motivate and set tone for team spirit
- Demonstrate technique and provide in-water coaching
- Attend team social events – Friday pep rally/pasta dinners, banquet, movie night, season kick-off social, ice cream socials, etc.
- Current CPR certification (Tallyho will reimburse)
- Ample opportunity for private lessons within the team and club if a coach on swim team; coaches set own fees and manage their own calendars
