- Knowledge of MCSL rules and procedures
- Familiarity with using various meet management technology/software
- Current lifeguard and CPR certifications are appreciated but not required

- Serve as a positive role model and promote good sportsmanship
- Coach morning and afternoon practices for ages 5-18
- Collaborate with other coaches in creating weekly meet line-ups for both A and B meets
- Help lead and manage at all meets, including weekly A & B dual Meets, Relay Carnival, Divisionals, All Star Meet, and MCSL Long Course meet
- Manage, guide, and train other assistant coaches
- Participate in team social events
- Communicate effectively with team representative, parents, and children
