- Rule Changes
 - O Noted that last year, the rule that swimmers can only wear the suits/caps of their summer league was expanded to apply to <u>all</u> "A" meets.
 - If someone swims with a cap/suit and it's not discovered until after the race, they will not be disqualified, but will be given a warning.
 - O USA Swimming adopted a technical change for IM and Medley Relay turns which MCSL will follow -- "Intermediate turns within each stroke shall conform to the turn rules for that stroke, except that in the freestyle turn, the swimmer must return to the breast before any kick or stroke."
