- Reminded the Reps to check your team's officials list to see who has graduated or has expired (a 2016 or earlier date) and will need to attend a clinic this Spring to re-certify. There are several clinics, please get the word out to your officials.

MCSL Reps Meeting

- All clinics will occur prior to the first “A” meet. There will be no additional clinics once they have concluded.
- Clinics Schedule:
 - Will kick off with the Advanced Ref clinic on Tuesday, May 22nd at 7:00pm @ MLK; Advanced Ref clinics will now provide recertification for Referees who are Starters. The on-line Advanced Ref Clinic date to be scheduled.
 - Sunday June 3 & 10 at either MLK or Olney
 - Monday, June 4th at 6:00pm @ Flower Hill -- Stroke & Turn only.
 - Wednesday, June 6th at 6:00pm @ Connecticut Belair -- Referee and Starter only.
- If a USA Swimming certified Stroke & Turn or Starter wants to certify with MCSL, there are instructions on the Officials page of the website.
- USA Swimming rule that MCSL will adopt -- the Ryan Lochte rule -- which has to do with the breaststroke to freestyle transition in the IM (“Once a legal touch has been made, the swimmer may turn in any manner and must return to the breast before any kick or stroke.”) This will be discussed during the Official’s clinics.

- MCSL will be using Meet Manager 4 – the same as last year.
