#### **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

- Assist the Head Coach in managing and coaching the CCRA Stingrays and Mini Rays teams.
- Supervise the Head Junior Coach in the management of the Junior Coaches.
- Spearhead team-building with weekly spirit themes and social opportunities.
- Report to the Head Coach and Swim Team A Representatives.

#### **EXPECTATIONS**

- Foster positive team spirit and kindness in competition.
- Promote a healthy balance between performance and FUN!
- Before the start of the season, confer with the Head Coach and A Representatives to identify areas of individual responsibility.
- Instruct swimmers of all ages in proper stroke technique.
- At all times, project a positive role model of professionalism for all swimmers and Junior Coaches.
- Have current CPR and lifeguarding certifications.
- Follow guidelines set forth in USA Swimming's Safe Sport Programming.
- Be knowledgeable about all MCSL governing rules and policies and observe them at all times.
- Check in frequently with the Head Coach and A Representatives regarding questions, concerns, and status reports.

## SPECIFIC DUTIES

- Assist the Head Coach with team management as required.
- Assist with practices, meets, and time trials as needed by the Head Coach.
  - Coordinate morning practice coaching schedule to ensure the appropriate number of coaches are on deck at all morning practices.
  - Keep the administrative calendar current with coaching assignments and planned absences.
  - Attend all afternoon Swim Team and Pre-team practices, scrimmages, and meets.
- Supervise the Head Junior Coach.
- Attend team social and team building events, including May Potomac Pizza Dinner, Back to the Pool Night, Friday night pasta dinners, and Team Banquet.
- Work with the Head Coach and Junior Coaches on “paper plate” awards.
- Instruct swimmers of all ages in proper stroke technique, including offering regular, positive, and constructive feedback.
- Work with the Head Coach regarding entries for Relay Carnival, Long Course, Divisional Meet, All-Star Relays, and Individual All Stars, and help ensure scratches are timely made and communicated.
