The Ladybugs will compete in Division H in 2025.

Job Requirements and Expectations:

- Previous experience as head coach, or at least 2-3 seasons as assistant coach
- Strong leadership and interpersonal skills
- Communicate effectively with team representatives, parents, and swimmers of all abilities
- Ability to recruit, manage, guide, train, and supervise assistant coaches during all practices and meets for the team, including preteam
- Ability to coach swimmers, regardless of ability level, in all 4 competitive strokes
- Ability to break down stroke mechanics and teach basic skills
- Develop plans for swim practices that balance stroke work, endurance training, and fun
- Provide constructive feedback and instruction to all swimmers
- Coach all daily morning and evening practices from Memorial Day through All-Star Weekend
- Coach all swim meets throughout the season from Time Trials through All-Stars
- Attend required MCSL and Division meetings
- Attend pre-season parent meeting and participate in pre-season planning as requested
- Create weekly line-ups for all meets: A meets, B meets, Relay Carnivals, Divisionals
- Lead and manage team at all meets, including Coaches Long Course and All-Stars
- Knowledge of MCSL policies, rules, and procedures
- Experience with SwimTopia a plus
- Current lifeguarding and CPR certifications required
