



King Farm Swim Team Assistant Coach – Summer 2026

The King Farm Swim Team (KFST) is seeking an Assistant Coach for the Screamin' Geese Swim Team. KFST is part of the Montgomery County Swim League (MCSL), competing over the summer swim season (late May – late July). The team has about 130 swimmers, holds practices Monday through Friday (mornings and afternoons), and participates in swim meets on Saturday mornings and Wednesday evenings. The mission of the team is to provide an opportunity for children aged 5-18 to have fun while building self-confidence, teamwork, community spirit, and good sportsmanship through friendly competitive swimming.

KFST Assistant Coach Job Responsibilities:

The Assistant Coach works under the supervision of the Head Coach to instruct and supervise swimmers at team practices, meets and other activities. The Assistant Coach is expected to provide direction and feedback to swimmers during practices and meets and occasionally lead practices and other activities independently, as directed. The Assistant Coach will lead Pre-Team activities and provide supervision, direction, and instructional training to the Pre-Team Coaches (swimmers age 11+) prior to the commencement of pre-team practices and during the season.

Responsibilities Include:

- Instruct and supervise swimmers during practices and meets
- Provide feedback to and assessments of swimmers and pre-team coaches
- Help plan, execute, and actively participate in spirit themes and activities each week
- Foster positive team spirit, sportsmanship, and kindness in competition
- Maintain a safe environment at practices and meets
- Professionally communicate with swimmers, coaches, KFST Board, and parents to provide timely and amicable resolution to questions or concerns
- Complete all paperwork, maintain records, and schedules related to regular and pre-team activities and meets, as assigned
- Complete routine maintenance of the pool area, including set-up and clean-up of practice area and pool flags
- Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

Current certifications in CPR/AED and First Aid required. Lifeguard Training certification is preferred. Ability to communicate effectively in a pool environment and demonstrate proper competitive swimming strokes and techniques to swimmers of all abilities is required. Knowledge of MCSL rules, regulations and procedures is preferred.

Experience: Must have competitive swim background. Prior leadership experience as a Swim Coach, Assistant Swim Coach or Swim Instructor preferred.

Education: High school diploma preferred.
