Team Leadership & Coaching

- Supervise and coordinate with the additional coaching staff, ensuring consistent strategies and swimmer support.
- Be a positive role model, always demonstrating professionalism and sportsmanship.

- Attend and actively coach at all MCSL events, including A & B dual meets, Time Trials, Divisionals, Relay Carnival, Coaches Long Course, and All-Star meets.
- Create and manage weekly meet lineups for A and B meets using Meet Manager in coordination with assistant coaches and automation volunteers.
- Coordinate lineup planning with coaching staff and submit meet entries on schedule.
- Communicate planned absences in advance to maintain coverage and continuity.

Mentorship & Staff Development

- Mentor the assistant coaching staff, including setting coaching objectives and providing regular feedback.

- Assist the Pre-Team Coach to ensure age-appropriate skill development and swimmer readiness for the full team.

Team Operations & Community Engagement

- Collaborate with Team Reps to maintain a supportive, organized, and high-energy team environment.
- Communicate regularly with families regarding swimmer progress, practice updates, and team events.
- Attend and support all team events, including spirit nights and the end-of-season banquet.
- Ensure the team adheres to MCSL Rules & Regulations and Safe Sport standards.
- Maintain current Lifeguard, CPR, and First Aid certifications.
