- Attend practices (morning and evening), meets, and swim team functions throughout the season, including pep rallies, team activities, and All-Star meets (including planning meetings for divisional meets)
- Provide hands-on coaching and supportive instruction during practice sessions, including instruction on stroke technique, starts, turns, and finishes for individual and relay events
- Create lineups for meets using SwimTopia (for home meets and most away meets) and communicate with opposing coaches as needed.
- Consult as needed with the Team Reps and Automation for meets, events, and swimmer/personnel concerns.
- Communicate as needed with parents and address questions and concerns in a timely fashion.
