Job Requirements and Expectations:

- Competitive swimming background
- Solid knowledge of and experience with teaching all four competitive strokes
- Ability to create and run different levels of practices based on the age and ability of the swimmers (focus will be swimmers 8 years old and older)
- Strong leadership and interpersonal skills with a positive attitude - must be able to communicate effectively and efficiently with the Head Coach, team representatives, swim team parents, and swimmers of all abilities
- Current certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR with AED, and First Aid
- Be very engaged in the team and with the swimmers to create a fun, rewarding experience for all team members
- Assist Head Coach at daily morning and afternoon/evening practices from Memorial Day through All-Star Weekend (8:30-10:00am Monday-Friday; 4-6:30pm Monday-Friday)
- Assist Head Coach at all swim meets throughout the season - from Time Trials through All-Stars, including all relay carnivals, long course meet, and TW's mini Meet for our PreTeam swimmers
- Participate in various weekly team-building activities on Friday afternoons from approximately 12-2pm (pizza party, movies, bowling, laser tag, etc.; note tickets/entrance fees are paid for by the swim team and are not at coach's expense)

- Must be at least 18 years old
