- Participating in pre-season planning meetings with Swim Team Parent Representatives
- Participating in all morning and afternoon swim team practices on weekdays and swim meets on Wednesdays and Saturdays during the swim season
- Supervising and leading the entire coaching staff
- Motivating and providing technical instruction and personal feedback to swimmers
- Devising and leading fun and spirited meet themes, and team events
- Communicating and coordinating daily with the staff
- Organizing all Assistant & Junior Swim Coaches' schedules and responsibilities to ensure all WMSPA swim team and pre-team practices and meets are sufficiently covered
- Designing developmentally appropriate and participation in swim practices for all swim groups
- Preparing meet entries according to the MCSL and B league rules
- Attending and coaching all scheduled meets for the WMSPA Swim Team, including, invitational meets and any meets that arise during the MCSL season

Current lifeguard & CPR certification is required before the commencement of the 2025 season. Knowledge of MCSL rules and procedures is a plus but not required. Wildwood offers competitive pay and opportunity to conduct private swim lessons.
