About Our Team

The Waves are a spirited and growing team of over 135 swimmers, including more than 30 pre-teamers, competing in Montgomery County Swim League (MCSL) Division I. We are committed to offering our swimmers a fun, inclusive, and competitive experience, with an emphasis on teamwork, sportsmanship, and individual improvement. Our pool is located at 511 Midsummer Drive, Gaithersburg, MD 20878.

Key Responsibilities

Team Leadership & Coaching

- Lead daily morning and afternoon practice sessions, with assigned afternoon lanes during open pool hours.
- Provide direct swim instruction and technique development for pre-team (ages 5–7) and developmental swimmers (ages 8+).
- Deliver in-water and on-deck coaching, focusing on the four competitive strokes.
- Promote team spirit by participating in and leading pep rallies, themed events, potlucks, and the end-of-season banquet.
- Serve as a positive role model of professionalism and sportsmanship.
- Coordinate with and supervise the Pre-team Coach to ensure an effective pre-team curriculum and B meet preparation.
- Mentor and coordinate with the Assistant Head Coach to ensure practice coverage and swimmer development.
- Lead preseason planning meetings with the Assistant Head Coach, Pre-Team Coach, Junior Coaches, and Team Reps to align on best practices and team goals.

Meet & Practice Management

- Attend all scheduled MCSL dual meets, A and B meets, Mini-Meets, Time Trials, Divisionals, Relay Carnival, Coaches Long Course, and All-Star events.
- Establish and communicate guidelines for meet entries in coordination with Team Reps and coaching staff.



- Present entry guidelines during a preseason meeting and post them to the team website.
- Work with the Assistant Head Coach and Automation Leads to prepare and submit meet data on time.
- Use Meet Manager and SportsEngine (or equivalent) to manage lineups, rosters, and schedules.
- Communicate planned absences in advance to ensure coaching coverage is maintained.

Mentorship & Staff Development

- Mentor Assistant Head Coach, Pre-Team Coach, and Junior Coaches (high school student swimmers).
- Assign coaching objectives, provide regular feedback, and foster leadership development.
- Help select recipients of end-of-season awards including high point trophies, spirit awards, and coaches' awards.

Team Operations & Safety

- Collaborate with Team Reps, Parent Leadership, and Assistant Coaches to maintain a positive and organized team environment.
- Communicate clearly and regularly with families regarding team events, meets, and swimmer progress.
- Attend and support registration day, Friday night socials, pep rallies, and the end-of-season banquet.
- Maintain current Lifeguard, CPR, and First Aid certifications.
- Demonstrate knowledge of MCSL Rules & Regulations.
- Uphold USA Swimming's Safe Sport standards.
